We will continue to support researchers from developing countries by offering fee waivers in APC's. PSM Biological Research offers a generous waiver scheme for qualifying authors. Corresponding authors from low-income countries (as classified by the World Bank) are eligible to apply for 100% waiver on article processing charges (APCs). Corresponding authors from lower middle-income countries are eligible to apply for a 50% discount on APCs. PSM members will receive a receive a 15% discount on APCs. All Editors and Editorial Board Members of PSM journals are entitled to publish their articles free of charge. Discounts cannot be combined or

applied to any other fees such as over-length article or color page charges.
